- Two F2964 forms must be completed (one to remove and one to attach) when:
 - Removing personalised plates and attaching them to a vehicle with a different registered operator; and/or
 - The personalised plates you are removing and attaching have different plate owners.
- Personalised plates can be attached to a vehicle registered in different name/s to the plate owner/s.
- Customised plates can only be attached to a vehicle registered in exactly the same name/s as the plate owner/s.
- Evidence of Identity (EOI), such as a Queensland Driver Licence, must be provided at time of lodgement for one registered operator of the vehicle and all plate owners. Refer to the separate *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Individuals Information Sheet (S5385)* or *Evidence of Identity Requirements for Organisations Information Sheet (S5386)* or tmr.qld.gov.au for EOI requirements.
- If you are removing standard number plates to attach personalised/customised plates, the standard plates must be returned with this application.
- You cannot attach or remove plates if the vehicle is under a Queensland Police Number Plate Confiscation Notice.
